

A2 Level – Elementary Spanish

Duration: 40 hours · 4 modules of 10 hours. This course is designed for learners with a basic knowledge of Spanish who want to **communicate more confidently and naturally in everyday situations**. The program follows the **A2 level of the CEFR** and uses a practical, communicative approach.

Module A2.1 – Everyday Communication

- Talking about routines and daily activities
- Describing people, places, and situations
- Comparing people and places
- Talking about the weather

Module A2.2 – Talking about the Past

- Talking about recent experiences
- Describing past events
- Expressing time and frequency
- Reacting to stories and news

Module A2.3 – Opinions and Plans

- Giving opinions and expressing likes
- Talking about wishes and intentions
- Expressing moods and feelings
- Talking about plans and projects

Module A2.4 – Interaction and Independence

- Making suggestions and invitations
- Asking for and offering help
- Communicating in shops and services
- Talking on the phone
- Asking for clarification and solving misunderstandings

By the end of Level A2, you will be able to:

- Communicate more fluently in everyday situations
- Talk about the past, the present, and future plans
- Express opinions and feelings with confidence
- Handle social situations with greater independence
