

A1 Level – Spanish for Beginners

Duration: 30 hours · 3 modules of 10 hours

A course for complete beginners who want to communicate in Spanish in basic everyday situations. The programme is aligned with CEFR A1 level, with a practical and communicative approach.

A1.1 – First Steps

- Introducing yourself and introducing other people
- Countries, nationalities and professions
- The alphabet and vowel pronunciation
- Days, months and seasons
- Gender and number: masculine, feminine and plural
- Questions and answers: affirmative and negative
- Expressing likes and preferences: the *gustar* structure
- Introduction to the present indicative

A1.2 – Everyday Communication

- Numbers and communication in shops, supermarkets and restaurants
- Your own routines and those of other people, and expressions of frequency
- Basic verbs: *ser*, *estar*, *haber* and *tener*
- Describing people, objects and places
- Continuing with the present indicative: irregular forms

A1.3 – Consolidation and Communication

- Consolidation of the content covered in A1.1 and A1.2
- Short conversations about everyday topics
- Integrated use of the vocabulary and structures learned
- Likes and preferences, routines and frequency
- Asking and answering questions and basic interaction
